

WALK THIS WAY THROUGH WINNIPEG'S BOOK DISTRICT



- I. Park your car near **Hargrave and Notre**Dame in one of the free 2 hr parking zones.

 Some of these have no 3:30 5:30 parking restrictions read the signs to find out.

 Nearby, there are metered parking spots and a few inexpensive lots. Street parking is free on weekends and in the evenings.
- II. Your BookWalk starts at **The Comic**Factory IV (map-1), which features science fiction, vintage toys and of course, comics. Next wander over to the **Goodwill Thrift Store** (map-1). Here you'll find collectible books on the second floor plus stacks of books on the main floor.
- III. Make sure you have plenty of time for the willy-nilly **Red River Books** (map-3). In amongst piles and piles of books, you'll find movies, comics, adult magazines and CDs.

 Next door is **Cinematheque** (100 Arthur: map-), which shows acclaimed independent and foreign films. Around the corner is local institution **Into The Music**, 245 McDermot (map-) In addition to their constantly changing stock of great CDs, Into The Music is THE place to buy vinyl in Winnipeg.

Take a break with a bite to eat at **Mondragon** (map-**3**), which will please your political palate with new books on radical feminism, collectivism and social action.

Their café has a completely vegan menu.

IV. Antiques and Funk (map-1) has a good selection of books, as well as funky furniture and kitschy stuff.

V. Ragpickers AntiFashion
Emporium & Books (map-♥) has
classic books, costumes and vintage fashion.
Next up is Toad Hall Toys (map-♥), an
Exchange District fixture since 1977, with
thousands of new children's books.

VI. Just outside of the Exchange District is Aqua Books (map-❷). Journalist Noah Richler anointed Aqua: "one of the craziest, most amusing and well-ordered second-hand bookstores I have ever frequented." This 8400 square foot building (dubbed Winnipeg's Cultural City Hall) houses 40,000 books, a huge events room (featuring 150 events a year), writers' studios, and the popular EAT! bistro (run by Red Seal Chef Candace Hughes). Also at AquaBooks.ca and EATbistro.ca.

VII. **Highbrow Books** (map-**⑤**) features the humanities, the sciences and literature.

SLIGHTLY WEST ON PORTAGE

Book Fair (inset map-**A**) is one of the city's oldest and most respected retailers of newer used books.

Bison Books (inset map-**B**) stocks better quality (mainly hardcover) books, with a particular emphasis on literary history and literary biographies.
